

# MILLARD COUNTY RECREATION WOMENS SLOW PITCH RULES

USSSA RULES WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS:

1. Game will begin at scheduled time.
2. No additions or changes on rosters after mid season – **May 26, 2016.**
3. All players must be freshman in High School (as of next fall).
4. Rainouts - If less than four innings have been played the game will be rescheduled. If four complete innings have been played the game is over and the score is final.
5. All teams must provide one scorekeeper 10 years of age or older. Failure to comply with this rule will result in forfeiting the game unless both teams agree on one scorekeeper during coin toss. (Umpire Enforced)
6. To be eligible for tournament, players must play in at least 6 league games. Recreation Dept. will keep track of player eligibility.
7. FREE SUBSTITUTION (Just like Co-Ed Softball) Player coming in takes batting order of player going out.
8. You don't have to finish with the same amount of players you started with.
9. Teams can use a designated hitter. Can bat up to 12 players.
10. 15 run rule after 4 innings.
11. Play at 70' bases.
12. Use Safety Home Plate
13. Bats must be stamped USSSA approved.
14. Allow courtesy runner but must be last out.
15. Pitcher has the option to wear mask, but it is **HIGHLY** recommended.
16. Each player on team pays a \$10 player fee up to 14 players per team.
