

## **Millard County 4-H Livestock & Horse Coordinator**

Millard County 4-H is now accepting applications for a part-time Livestock Coordinator position. This position will be 520 hours a year, approximately 50 hours per month from January to September. The starting rate will be \$10.39 per hour based on the Millard County step and grade. Duties for this position will be: to oversee the 4-H portion of the Livestock show, attend stock show board meetings, work with volunteers to plan and assist on tagging days, recruit volunteers to develop and run 4-H Clubs within the Livestock area, assist the Agriculture Professor and 4-H staff with Millard County Fair; assist in other 4-H Development areas as needed. This person will oversee the whole county. Minimum age of 21 with a high school diploma or equivalent required. Previous experience with livestock required. Applications are available online at millardcounty.org, in both 4-H Extension Offices, and at Workforce Services. Applications and Resumes can be turned in at the Extension offices in Delta 83 S. Manzanita Ave. and Fillmore 50 S. Main. The position deadline is January 1, 2020, or until filled.
