

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-1

A RESOLUTION DECLARING UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES FOR THE TWO VACANT COUNCIL POSITIONS ELECTED AND ONE MAYORAL POSITION ELECTED, TOWN OF MEADOW, UTAH.

Purpose:

To cancel the 2019 Election of the Town Council of Meadow Town.

Statement of Policy:

The Council of the Town of Meadow did duly order a municipal election to be held on November 5, 2019, to elect two (2) Councilmen and one (1) Mayor.

WHEREAS, as of 5:00 PM, June 7, 2019, the deadline for filing for a place on the ballot, each person whose name is to appear on the ballot is unopposed, and;

WHEREAS, as of 5:00 PM, September 3, 2019, no candidate's name is to be placed on a list of write-in candidates for those offices, and;

WHEREAS, the mayor, serving as official receiving applications for a place on the ballot, has presented certification that no candidate is opposed and that no proposition is to appear on the ballot.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MEADOW, UTAH:

As authorized by Title 20A-1-206 of the Utah Election Code, the following candidates for council and mayor are declared to be elected:

COUNCIL – TYSON DEWOLF
COUNCIL – DUSTAN STARLEY
MAYOR – LYNETTE MADSEN

AND THAT the election previously ordered for November 5, 2019, not be held for these positions and that a copy of this order be posted on Election Day at each polling place that would have been used in the election.
